How to perform the gradient maneuver with an automatic vehicle

- 1 First you must indicate to the left (pull aside and stop)
- 2 Second you put on your hazard lights
- 3 Third put your gear lever in the park position
- 4 Forth pull up your hand brakes
- 5 Fifth turn off your vehicle (engine)

To move off

- 1 First start your car
- 2 Put your foot on the brakes
- 3 Select your gear i.e. (D= drive)
- 4 Move your foot from the brakes and place it on the gas peddle
- 5 Squeeze the gas peddle gently to bring the (RPM) revolution per minute up to 1100
- 6 Hold it at 1100 RPM
- 8 Put down your hand brakes
- 9 Cancel your hazard lights
- 10 Look in your mirrors (to see if it is safe)
- 11 Indicate to the right (to move off)
- 11 if it is safe you move off
